Climbing vine, various soils, purple/blue berries, leaves turn red in fall

**Virgins Bower** *Clematis virginiana*

Climbing vine, average soils, white flowers, July-August

**Native Shrubs & Wildflowers**

**Full to Partial Sun/Dry to Average, Well-drained Soils**

**Black-Eyed Susan** *Rudbeckia hirta*

1' to 3' tall, rich yellow flowers, June to October, biennial or perennial

**Hairy Beardtongue** *Penstemon hirsutus*

1'-2' tall, trumpet-like, lavender flowers with white lips, June-July

**Hoary Vervain** *Verbena stricta*

2'-10' tall, blue candelabra-like flowers, July-September

**Evening Primrose** *Oenothera biennis*

2' to 6' tall, yellow flowers, June-Sept.

**Fireweed** *Epilobium angustifolium*

4' to 6' tall, purple-pink flower spikes, July-September

**Lance-leaved Coreopsis** *Coreopsis lanceolata*

1' to 2' tall, 1½" to 2½" yellow flowers, June to August

**Tall sunflower** *Helianthus giganteus*

3' to 10' tall, many light yellow 3" flowers, July-September

**Woodland sunflower** *Helianthus divaricatus*

3' to 6' tall, many 3" yellow flowers, July-September

**Common Milkweed** *Asclepias syriaca*

3'-5' tall, dull purplish flowers, June to August, only food for Monarch butterfly larvae

**Wild Columbine** *Aquilegia canadensis*

1' to 2.5' tall, red flowers with yellow centres, May-June

**Nodding Wild Onion** *Allium cernuum*

1' to 2' tall, pink/white flowers, July-August,

**Blanket Flower** *Gaillardia aristata*

18" to 30" tall, flowers red/orange centre, yellow margins, June-Oct.

**Dwarf Blazingstar** *Liatris cylindraceae*

1' to 3' tall, purple flowers, July-Sept.

**Spreading Dogbane** *Apocynum androsaemifolium*

1' to 2.5' tall, pink, small bell-shaped flowers, June-July

**Grey-Headed Coneflower** *Ratibida pinnata*

3' to 5' tall, drooping yellow petals, July-August, very drought tolerant

**Culver's Root** *Veronicastrum virginicum*

3' to 6' tall, many small white tubular flowers, July-August

**Prairie Smoke** *Geum triflorum*

6" to 18" tall, rusty, pinkish flowers, May-July, seed head have "feather duster" look

### Full to Partial Sun/ Moist to Wet Soils

**Marsh Marigold** *Caltha palustris*

8"-24" tall, 1"-1.5" yellow flowers, April-June

**Joe-Pye-Weed** *Eupatorium maculatum*

4' to 7' tall, clusters of pink flowers, July-September

**Boneset** *Eupatorium perfoliatum*

2' to 5' tall, clusters of small white flowers, July-August

**Blue Flag Iris** *Iris versicolor*

2' to 3' tall, blue flowers, June-July

**Cardinal Flower** *Lobelia cardinalis*

2' to 4' tall, scarlet flower spikes, July-Sept.

**White Turtlehead** *Chelone blabra*

1' to 4' tall, white tubular flowers, July-August

### Shrubs and Vines

**Red Osier Dogwood** *Cornus stolonifera*

up to 6' tall, full sun to light shade, moist to average soils, small white flower clusters, white/bluish berries, Aug.-Sept.

**Pussy Willow** *Salix discolor*

6' to 10 tall', full sun to light shade, moist to wet soils, catkins in spring

**Riverbank Grape** *Vitis riparia*

climbing vine, full sun to partial shade, birds eat fruit
